## *Wherefore art thou...*

We encourage you to use what we have available. To make that easier, here is a site map to help you locate (or discover) some of the amenities we offer. The point is to have fun, be comfortable and enjoy yourselves!



## *Kitchen*

Dishes are pretty obvious, but if you want to create a mood, don't miss some of the fun dishes on the top shelves. The dark red dishes on the top shelf create a wonderful setting.

- There are also many appliances. Here is a list of some of the less obvious items:
  - Blender ~ lower cupboard next to the dishwasher
  - Electric skillet ~ lower bottom right cupboard
  - Bread maker ~ lower bottom right cupboard
  - Pots/Pans/baking dishes ~ bottom drawer of oven and first lower cupboard on the left.
  - Plastic ice bucket and trays (great for outside) ~ lower shelf to the left of the sink.
  - Large steamer pot for clams / crabs, etc. ~ on shelf or floor in kitchen pantry.



# *Kitchen*

There are lots of staples in the cupboard and in the pantry. (Shelves by kitchen door next to dishwasher). Please feel free to use them. If something runs out and you can replace it, great... But no worries, leave us a note so we can replace it. Look around and use what is available. Some of the items on hand:

- Olive oil ~ pantry
- Balsamic vinegar ~ pantry
- Various spices ~ in cupboard over the dishwasher and on counter in spice dolly
- Coffee ~ yippee! On the bottom shelf in the cupboard above the dishwasher. We buy French Roast (and organic when available at the Red Apple in Westport). There is a coffee maker on the kitchen counter.
- Various teas ~ cupboard above dishwasher.



## *Bar Items*

The Wild Rose is a great place to sip a glass of wine... Or whatever suits your fancy. We have an assortment of glasses.

- Wine glasses ~ hanging on the two wine racks on either side of the window in the dining room.
- Margarita glasses ~ on the second shelf in the cupboard on the left in the kitchen.
- Cocktail glasses ~ on the first shelf in the cupboard on the left in the kitchen
- Various glasses ~ in the bar downstairs
- Cork screws ~ in the first or second drawer in the kitchen



## *Get Cozy...*

- The propane fireplaces are on thermostats. The upstairs thermostat is remote and is usually left on the table by the couch or on the mantel. The downstairs thermostat is fixed and on the wall behind the fireplace. They will automatically shut off when the temperature reaches 2° higher than the set point. Adjust as needed. There is a blower adjustment dial on the side of each stove. (There is also a switch that **must** remain in the off position so that the thermostats work... Please do not touch! ;-} )
- Don't miss the great comforters rolled in the antique bread bowl ~ on the floor by the window behind the dining table.
- All of the beds have down comforters but if you're still chilly (we've never had that problem), there are an assortment of old blankets in the closet of the Queen bedroom downstairs.



## *Entertainment*

- Selections of DVDs and Videos are located in the wall unit cupboard to the right of the upstairs tv and in the wicker bookshelf and cupboard to the right of the downstairs tv.
- A CD / tape / radio / record player is located in the cupboard of the left wall unit next to the tv. Please use the remote only to adjust volume. There is a limited selection of CDs
- DVD-VCR is attached to the downstairs tv. Children and Pre-teen movies are located downstairs
- The Poker Table top lifts off for game playing (But you can just as easily play on the top!)
  - Check for additional cards, etc. in the wicker bookshelf drawers.
- Miscellaneous games are in the wicker bookcase cupboards.
- Jigsaw puzzles are in the little bookshelf at the bottom of the stairs.



## *Sauna*

- We want you to be comfortable... There are 6 spa robes for your use hanging in the Blue bedroom upstairs and a basket of small towels in the sauna for sitting on.
- The sauna is wired for sound. There is a CD/Radio/Tape player in the upper right cupboard in the Master bedroom. Please leave the cupboard doors open when in operation.
- Please do not get sand in the sauna! If you've been to the beach be sure and use the **outdoor shower** before getting in ~ it's best to shower before taking a sauna anyway... The shower has hot (let it run for a few minutes) and cold water.



## *Deck Accessories*

- Deck table, chairs, and bench are on the deck (covered in winter)
- Small propane BBQ on the rail of the deck ~ outside the sliding door.
- Deck chairs ~ In winter the cushions are in the downstairs closet under the stairs.
- Fire pit is in the yard. Please be careful with the flames in dry weather! Be aware of any Burn Bans in effect!



## *The Beach*

The path to the beach...

- The Wild Rose Hideaway property goes all the way to the beach and consists of some wetland and rough terrain. Our path is under construction. It is currently pretty rough, but useable. We hope to have it completed before the winter rains. Walk out the gate in the back and straight ahead, you'll see the mowed path. Watch for the deer and the coyotes playing on the path!
- You can also drive to the beach. Take a right out of the driveway and go to the beach access road (just beyond The Local Bar and Grill) and take a right.

All the beaches between Westport and Tokeland are great. A couple of our favorites are:

- The Dune Trail from the light house to Westport. Take a left out of the driveway and drive straight ahead several miles and take a left at Ocean Ave. Go visit the light house and then follow the path (about 2 miles) to Westport. It's a beautiful walk, bike ride, etc.
- "Wash away beach" in North Cove. Take a right out of the driveway and drive several miles. Take your first right (Old State Hiway) past the Minit Market. You'll dead end. Park and walk on the beach. There is often more driftwood and washed up treasures here.

**Note ~ There are some beach mats in the little nook by the front door.**



## *Misc. Supplies*

Everything should be well stocked where you need it, but if you don't see something, try looking for it in the following places...

- Paper towels and toilet paper ~ closet in downstairs bathroom.
- Cleaning supplies ~ under kitchen sink or on the floor in the kitchen pantry.
- Vacuum cleaner ~ right hand closet in the Green upstairs bedroom
- **Baby Gates!** ~ left hand closet in the Green upstairs bedroom. We use them for our puppies!
- Clean bed linens are in the hall linen closet upstairs (King beds), in the downstairs bathroom closet (twins), and on the top shelf in the closet of the downstairs Queen bedroom (queen).



# *Services*

- **Local phone service:** You can dial local numbers from our phone. A phone card will get you long distance service. The only reliable cell phone service is Verizon

## *Groceries*

- Ted's Red Apple Market in Westport is a very good place to get groceries, 108 S Montesano, Westport.
  - Take a left out of the driveway. Go several miles to the first stop sign. Take a right and go to the only stop light in Westport. The market is across the street.
- For smaller items there are several little groceries between Grayland and North Cove, we like The Beachcomber Grocery and Deli at 1605 SR 105, Grayland.
- Oysters ~ Brady's Oysters, 3714 Oyster Pl E., Westport (Off State Rt 105 just before you get to Westport / Grayland). See their flyer on the rack in the parlor
- Crab, etc. ~ Always try the docks for seafood availability first! If not there, We prefer Nelson's in Tokeland... Or Bradys
- Bay City Sausage has great sausage! We really like their chorizo. 2249 State Rt 105 ~ 360-648-2344. See their flyer on the rack in the parlor
